



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

### To All Interested Parties:

Government Code section 11346.1 (a)(2), as amended by AB 302, Chapter 73, Statutes of 2006, requires that an adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. The notice shall be provided to those persons at least five working days before submitting an emergency regulation to the Office of Administrative Law. After submission of the proposed emergency to the Office of Administrative Law, the Office of Administrative Law shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations to the Office of Administrative law as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.

Attached are the proposed emergency regulations by the Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology & Hearing Aid Dispensers Board relating to Renewal Fee Schedules and Continuing Professional Development for Dispensing Audiologists. Also attached is the Board's Finding of Emergency.

The Board plans to have a hearing on these regulations in the very near future and will send out notices as soon as the date of the hearing is determined.
