**General Provisions/Exemptions Relating to Joint Rule 61 Deadlines**

1. Bills acted upon by a committee deadline for which amendments are recommended have two legislative days after that deadline during which they may be reported (J.R. 61(c)).
2. Rules Committees are exempted from these deadlines (J.R. 61(f)).
3. Bills which are referred to an Assembly committee (pursuant to J.R. 26.5 or A.R. 77.2) are exempted from these deadlines (see also J.R. 61(g), J.R. 61(h)).
4. A policy committee or fiscal committee may meet for the purpose of hearing and reporting a constitutional amendment, or a bill which would go into immediate effect pursuant to Section 8 of Article IV of the Constitution at any time other than those periods when no committee may meet for any purpose (J.R. 61(i)).
5. Joint and Concurrent Resolutions are exempted from these deadlines (J.R. 6).
